FRANCE

GERMANY

ITALY

Aquafan, Riccione – One of Europe's largest water parks, Aquafan offers loads of



fun for the kiddos and parties for adults, so lather on the sunscreen and get going. Then spend a day in the nearby Republic of San Marino, a settlement nestled 2,100 feet above Italian villages that retains much of its medieval character.

Gardaland, Castelnuovo del Garda –

Among the most popular amusement parks in Europe, Gardaland is 20 miles from historic Verona and 90 miles from the City of Water, Venice. Enjoy a nice balance of thrill rides and fun for young children. Kids will love the circus show, "Madagascar Live!" www.gardaland.it
